With a proven and up-to-date design, vessel construction is based on a commercially proven hull design developed for efficient operation in turbulent and stormy weather. Spray rails throw water away from the vessel, while a self-draining deck and excellent stability retains vessel trim providing a dry, safe and comfortable journey. The low resistance of the hull design and HDPE material allows the SeaViper to quickly get onto plane and achieve speed whatever the weather.

Together with its adeptness to sail in all sea states, the SeaViper workboat delivers a fuel-efficient, low maintenance vessel with unparalleled seakeeping.

Constructed to Bureau Veritas rules and RCB compliant, the SeaViper is offered in three standard sizes. Vessel configuration is dependant upon operational use, deck space, seating and propulsion requirements:
